



Mixed Harmony Brigade of New England Terms and Conditions of Registration and Participation

1 Cancellation Policy

You may cancel your participation in the New England Mixed Harmony Brigade Rally at any time, but we are only able to refund part of the cost of the event according to the following policy:

1. If your registration is not accepted for any reason:
 - ***you do not need to pay anything and/or will receive a full refund for any fees already paid***
2. If you cancel your application within 7 days after applying AND prior to receiving an acceptance email:
 - ***you do not need to pay anything and/or you will receive a full refund for any fees already paid***
3. If you cancel your registration after being accepted for the New England Mixed Harmony Brigade,
 - At least 90 days before that start-date of the event: ***any unpaid portion of the total fee is due immediately, and you will receive a refund or credit of one-half of the total fee***
 - Within 90 days of the start-date of the event: ***no refund can be provided and any unpaid portion is due immediately***
4. If you do not notify the Brigade of a cancellation but do not attend the Rally, any unpaid portion is due immediately
5. In the unlikely event the Harmony Brigade Rally needs to be canceled for any reason, you will receive a proportional refund of the funds remaining (receipts for this event less expenses for this event) divided among the people having registered. A full accounting of the costs will be provided to everyone registered.

2. Other Terms and Conditions

The Mixed Harmony Brigade of New England (MHBNE) is organized on a non-profit basis and run by unpaid volunteers, with the objective of providing a unique quartet and chorus singing experience. Participation requires particular skills and experience, and extensive preparation by each participant. It is a condition of registration that you commit to devoting sufficient time and energy to preparation (individual song-learning and rehearsal) such that you come to the Brigade fully prepared and able to sing all songs word and note perfect. People registering for the MHBNE Rally participate entirely at their own risk and shall hold the organizers and the Mixed Harmony Brigade MHBNE harmless against any loss, injury or other consequence of their participation. The MHBNE will transfer the appropriate portion of your fees to the venue suppliers (hotel and conference center) on your behalf, but the contract and any claims arising from your stay are strictly between you and the hotel. Participants are required to conduct themselves in a lawful and orderly manner and to abide by the rules of the venue where a MHBNE Rally is being held. The organizers of the MHBNE have the right to exclude any person from participation in any or all Mixed Harmony Brigade of New England activity if, in their sole judgement, the person is unprepared or unfit in any way to achieve the standards expected for the activity or activities in question. The organizers of the MHBNE also have the right to exclude any person who fails to comply to the rules of the venue where the MHBNE Rally is being held and/or to MHBNE rules communicated by the organizers. Any person so excluded from any current or future activity shall have no right of redress or compensation.
